



Captain Application Information

The title of Jesuit Cheer Captain will only be awarded to Sophomores for the position of Junior Varsity Captain, and Seniors for the position of Varsity Captain. Freshmen and Juniors need not apply.

- o Responsibilities of the captain include but are not limited to:
 - Setting an example for the rest of the squad and program as set forth in the Program Handbook and Jesuit Athletic Handbook.
 - Being punctual to all Jesuit Cheer-related events (*practice, games, volunteer events, etc.*).
 - Maintaining a 3.0 GPA or higher.
 - Team communication, motivation and spirit.
 - Working closely with the Coaching Staff/Committee Heads on projects and events.
 - Selecting chants to be performed at games.
 - Greeting and welcoming visiting Cheerleaders at games.
 - Working cooperatively with Jesuit and UA student associations to organize events.
 - Coordinating painting and hanging of signs for the games and events.
- o Application Requirements and Selection Process
 - Please turn in a well-written essay that describes, in detail, why you deserve the title of Jesuit Cheer Captain for your respective squad. Be sure to explain what leadership qualities you possess, as well as how you plan to help manage your teammates and any issues that may arise.
 - o 1 full page (*Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced*)
 - 2 Recommendation Questionnaires – email
 - o Questionnaires must be completed by individuals other than family members
 - A current teacher at Ursuline
 - Coach, family friend, or another teacher (current or past)
 - Interview with the Coaching Staff
 - Talk to the team
